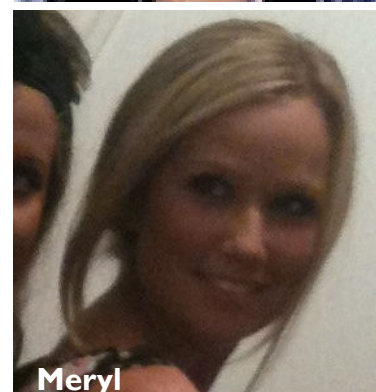
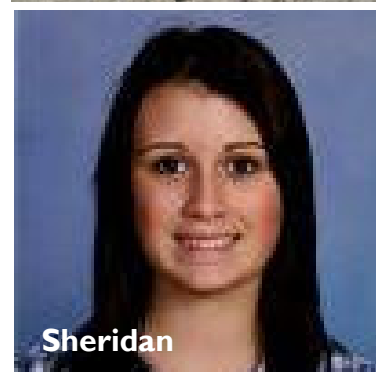
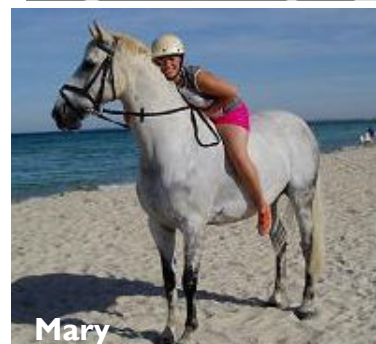

We were the last lucky family to have him. He taught many kids to ride, albeit at a speedy rate! Lisa Tyrrell

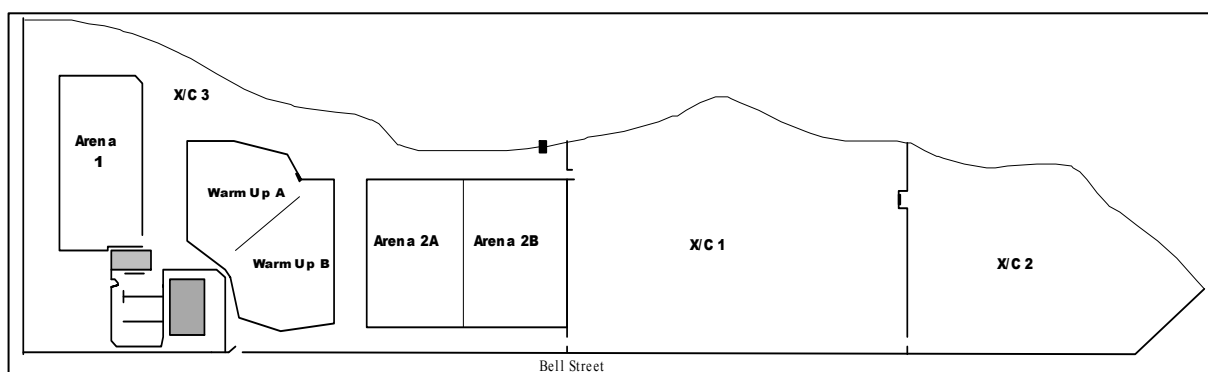
Rest in peace little Gus. You will be sadly missed by all at Pony Club and our love and best wishes go to Emily and her family.
