- Wire cutters;
- Empty big Syringes;
- Towel;
- Zinc:
- Vaseline;
- Water bottle;
- Tweezers;
- Poultice (Animal Lintex).

Try to read through and fill in as much as you can in the book for general questions so that they can be signed off as well.
