## President's Report

My recent fishing trip up to the Kimberleys was great, but unfortunately someone forgot to tell the fish that they were actually supposed to bite the bait, so in the end I didn't catch much of anything – but that's fishing I guess – maybe next time!

### Dressage Day

Our annual Dressage Day is coming up on the 15th August, which replaces our normal rally day. We could not have it on our normal 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month this year, as it clashed with another club in our area having a competition, and PCAV/NMZ have new rules which specify that no two clubs within a zone can run a competition on the same day. Entry forms are now on our website, and will be available from the clubrooms at this coming rally. Entries strictly close on the 4<sup>th</sup> August, but do me a favour and get them in early if you can.

A working bee for the Dressage Day will be held on Sunday the 8<sup>th</sup> at 9.30am, with set-up day being on Saturday the 14<sup>th</sup> at 1.30pm. Please keep these dates clear as you are expected to attend.

### Membership Fees

All membership fees should have been paid at our last rally. We have still not received payment from a few riders, and at this stage we are assuming that they are not returning. If that is not the case, you need

to contact either Ria Brenchley or myself immediately, before this coming rally.

### Your Involvement

As we have had a number of new families join the club recently, I thought it would be a good time to remind all of our members that each family is expected to do their part for the club. We offer on our membership form an exemption fee of \$175 per year, which excludes you from any work duties throughout the year (that money goes towards paying for some of the grounds jobs such as slashing etc.). This year we have had only one family take up that offer, which is fine, so we expect that the rest of our members are happy to do their bit for the club – please make sure it happens. On average, you are expected to do at least one session of canteen duty, one grounds set-up / pack-up, and one working bee per year. You must also help out at one of our two competition days that we run each year. This is not a lot to expect – at some smaller clubs you are expected to work at almost every rally! This is also a good way to meet people, which makes Pony Club a more friendly environment.

Well that's it from me. If you need to be graded at this rally please give me a call so I can write you in my book.






