Great news this month, five of our fabulous senior riders took on the best in the State and WON the Horse Trials!!! Congratulations. We are very proud not only for your amazing riding success, but also for your awesome team spirit and the way you helped and supported each other at this event. Not to forget your brave and honest four legged partners whom I am sure are enjoying all the fanfare and treats that claiming the title of 'State Horse Trials Team Champions' has bestowed on them. Individual results are as follows: Naomi and Mighty Tosca - 1st grade 1, Sheridan and Simotty - 1st grade 2, Mary and Frogswell - 2nd grade 2. Excellent results also for Jarryd with Nobodys Fool and Meryl with Drummer who were competing at State Champs for the first time and both finished well up the leader board.

A couple of reminders. Firstly for rally days. **ALL RIDERS MUST ENTER AND EXIT THE TIE-UP AREA UNMOUNTED.** Under no circumstances are you to ride in this area IT IS A SAFETY ISSUE. Also when you are moving from one area to another or back to the clubrooms/tie-ups you must do so at a WALK. We have some very young members and siblings in our club please look out for them. It is also disruptive to other groups who may still be under instruction.

Regarding Grading Cards: remember to use the same horse/pony's name at pony club rally gear check as is written in your card. This also applies when you fill in entry forms for a competition i.e.- if you have a Show name you like to use for comps, that must be the name in your card not your horse/pony's paddock or stable name. If it is not the same, you may not be permitted to ride.

Our next couple of rallies (June & July) we will be working more towards a dressage focus in preparation for our Dressage Day in August. Dressage is an important part of us all becoming better riders and training our mounts to listen to our aids and be more balanced, therefore giving us a more comfortable enjoyable ride. Even if it is not your favourite discipline it can help you with acceptance of the bit, the shortening/lengthening of strides between obstacles and generally improve the effectiveness of your seat, leg and hand, this will improve the responsiveness and control of your horse.

Last weekend I had the opportunity to watch and listen in as Australian Dressage rider Brett Parberry (World Equestrian Games 2010) gave some lucky young riders lessons and a master class. Something I was reminded of was a thing called the 'classical training scale' that refers to five necessary points of

training. They are **Rhythm, Suppleness, Impulsion, Straightness and Contact.** You can ask your instructor about what they mean, having a better understanding of these and reminding yourself of them when training on your own is very beneficial.

For those of you that like a bit of excitement (and I think that's all of you!) the rallies after the dressage day will have a Show Jumping focus. This will include learning the rules for the different types of events as well as some great coaching from our instructors and a Freshmans Day. (fingers crossed)

We also hope to have a trail ride in the warmer months and if any of you think a 'Pony Club Camp' would be good idea let me know, if there is enough interest we will look into it.

We have Seville Pony Club 'Future Stars' in this newsletter. This month is Red group. Take a look and remember to say hi when you see them around our club. Also please check the rally groups and plan, there will be a 'C' certificate group and a 'D*' group at this rally as we need to get you ready for testing and exams that are coming up. Remember to bring (and wear) your name badges and arm bands and to put your Parent/Guardian's name down at gear check. See you all at the next rally.
