President's Report

Apart from the rain, our Dressage Day seemed to be a success and ran like clockwork. Thank you to all the volunteers & families that made the day run so smoothly. 46 out of 65 families helped out on the day — a great effort. A special thanks here to Jenni Eggleston for doing such a great job of organising & co-ordinating all of the volunteers — it's not an easy job by any means, but she does it so well year after year.

The weather was a bit against us on the day, but I hope that all of our riders that did compete enjoyed themselves, and that you might have even done well in the placings.

It was great to see that we finally won our own SPC Perpetual Dressage Day Shield back — the first time since 1996! Congratulations to our winning team of Mary Fildes, Marion Peters, Megan Deans & Tayla-Jane Deacon — well done girls.

The new tie up area worked well for the dressage day, and should make a big difference for our own rally days. Again a huge thank you to everyone that turned up on the day to help with the construction side of things, or just to give the place a good tidy up. 26 families out of 65 turned up for the working bee which was a terrific performance. It was great to see people turn up that may not have known a hammer from a nail, but were still prepared to help others in

any way they could — thank you.

Whilst on the subject of those that pitched in, we are now keeping a chart of who turns up for the allocated duties (canteen, set-up etc) and to the working bees. **Please make sure that you either sign the attendance sheet on the day, or at least let someone of responsibility know that you were there.**

On the same subject it is great to see so many of our newer members helping out at the moment. This is probably the best way to meet new people within the club and to feel like you are actually part of a club — keep it up.

Our thanks to the Shire of Yarra Ranges for the issue of financial grants which will cover the bulk of this work, and also to Christine Cellante for putting in all the hard work to obtain the grant.

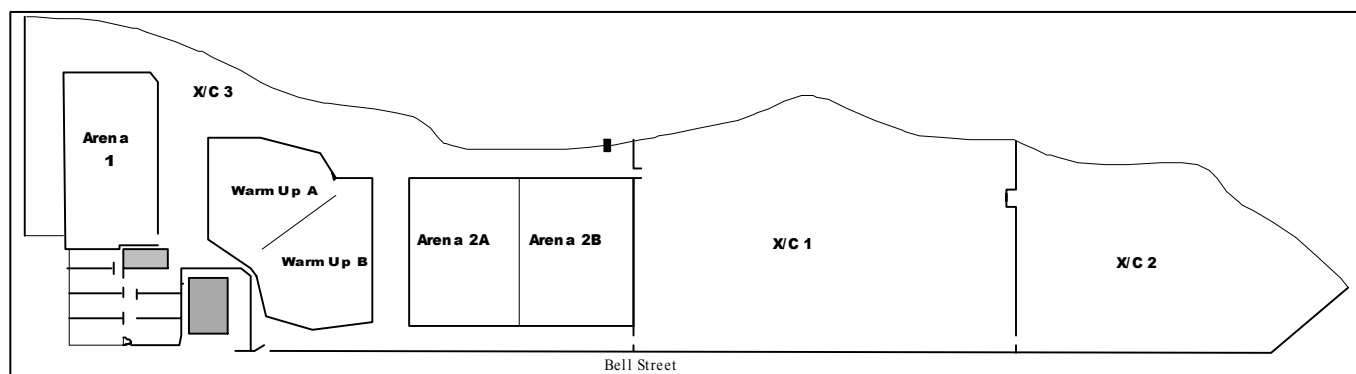
